

## How to make the best video of your dressage test

The arena needs to be set up according to the 40ft x 20ft plan as illustrated with all markers clearly visible from marker C

You can either memorize the test or have it called for you.

Have the videographer position himself in line with marker C and at the right distance away so that the entire horse and rider are visible as they go by. It is important that the videographer is perfectly in line with the marker so that the center line is straight or you may lose marks.

Ensure the entire arena is visible, noise and clutter free, so please, no children, dogs, chickens, kitty cats etc!

The video must be done in one session, not “pieced together” from several sessions!

Be sure the videographer uses landscape format, using the zoom feature as the horse moves away and that the horse is always in the center of the screen. A tripod is advisable.
